



Design No: 33
Snowflake Poncho



woolybutt Exclusive Design

Size: age 2 – 4 years

Materials: 1 x 100g ball of Sirdar Snowflake Chunky
6.5mm needles
5.5mm crochet hook



Instructions:

Cast on 75 stitches using the thumb method.

Knit in garter stitch until work measures 25cm (for a longer poncho knit until piece is 30cm).

Cast off loosely.

Make a second identical piece.

Join short edge of rectangle of one piece to long edge of rectangle of second piece. Do the same on the other side.

Neck edge:

Row 1: take a 5.5mm crochet hook and crochet 1dc into each stitch of neck cast off stitches.

Crochet around neck. Join with a sl st to beg, dc.

Row 2: using st still on hook *make 8 ch, skip 3 dc, 1dc into next dc*, repeat this all the way around neckline (the effect will be a series of loops), join with a sl st to starting point.

Row 3: *make 2ch, 1dc into top of loop*, repeat this right around neckline until starting point is reached, finish off.

A ribbon can be threaded through the loops or a matching plaited piece of Snowflake to finish the garment.

Note: to make garment bigger or smaller add or subtract 10 stitches.

The material used in this garment was Sirdar Snowflake Chunky however Patons Powder Puff or Baby Velvet or Wendy Darling could be used but the yarn would have to be used double.
