Avignon Stardust Poncho



woolybutt Exclusive Design

Size: fits all

Materials: 2 (3) x 50g balls of Heirloom “Avignon” plus 1-2 balls for the crochet edging if desired.

12mm needles

10mm crochet hook

Note: this pattern also works with other lightweight 12ply mohairs.

Tension: 8 stitches to 10cm over pattern

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Instructions:

Make two pieces each as follows:

Cast on 48 (56) stitches LOOSELY.

Note: to make a neat firm edge, slip the first stitch of every row.

Leave ends of about 30cm at the cast on and cast off points for sewing up.

Pattern (make 2):

Row 1 -4 : slip the first stitch, knit to the end.

Row 5: sl 1, k3, *yfwd k2tog., repeat from * to last 4 stitches, knit 4.

Row 6: sl 2, k3, *yfn, p2 tog., repeat from * to last 4 stitches, knit 4.

Repeat Rows 1-6 four times (five times for larger size), i.e. do them 5 (6) times in all.

Repeat Rows 1-4 once. Cast off LOOSELY.

Sew pieces together, right sides facing, ends to side using thread left at cast on/cast off.

Crochet edging:

With right sides facing and using a 10cm hook, join yarn with a slip stitch at a join (note: keep yarn slack and crochet LOOSELY).

Round 1: 1ch, 1dc in each stitch (gaps between ridges).

At corners work (1dc, 1ch, 1dc) in each corner stitch.

Join round with a sl stitch into ch1.

Round 2: ch4, miss 1dc, 1tr in next dc, 1ch, miss 1dc, 1tr in next dc, repeat from around.

At corners: 1ch, 1tr in each dc and in one ch space at corner.

Join round with a sl st into 3rd ch of original ch4.
